CELEBRATIONS AROUND THE WORLD

People in India celebrate **Holi** festival. It is the festival of colours. Children like playing with colours and water balloons. This festival usually happens on 25th March.



Songkran is a festival in Thailand. It is their New Year celebration. There is music and dancing on the streets. People pour each other with water. It is celebrated on 13th April.



La Tomatina is a festival in Spain. People go out on the streets and throw tomatoes at each other. This festival means that summer is over. It is celebrated on 30th August.



Irish people celebrate **St. Patrick's Day**. People play traditional Irish music. There are parades. Everybody wears something green. It is celebrated on 17th March.



Carnival is one of the most famous festivals in the world and is celebrated in Brazil. There are parades and samba music everywhere. It is celebrated on 9th February.
