You can view it from both the sides of the river, as well as from the old brick across the Venta, which is 200 m downstream from the waterfall.

Cheese rolling in England



Cheese rolling happens every spring. From the top of the hill, people push down a wheel of cheese. People then chase after it, down the 182-meter-long hill. The first person to cross the line at the bottom of the hill, wins the race, and the wheel of cheese.

Birthday cake in face



Here in Mexico, the birthday girl or boy has their hands behind their back. As they take the first bite of the birthday cake, the other party guests cheer loudly and push the face into the cake, saying "Mordida! Mordida! Mordida!", which means 'take a bite' in Spanish.
